

BYLAW NO. 2017-07

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TROCHU

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

“TO APPOINT THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL”

WHEREAS, section 150 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, provides for a municipality to appoint the position of the Chief Elected Official from among duly elected council members, and

AND WHEREAS, section 159 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, provides for Council to determine the term of a Chief Elected Official, and

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Trochu duly assembled, under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended enact the following;

PART 1. – TITLE,

1. This bylaw shall be known as “TO APPOINT THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL”

PART 2. – DEFINITIONS,

2.1 In this bylaw, unless the context requires otherwise;

- (a) “Act” means the Municipal Government Act, , R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended,
- (b) “Bylaw” means a bylaw of the Town of Trochu
- (c) “Council” means the Mayor and Councillors of the Town of Trochu

PART 3. – PURPOSE,

- 3.1 That the position of the Chief Elected Official shall be appointed from duly elected council members.
- 3.2 That the appointment of the Chief Elected Official shall be, for the full extent of, but not beyond the term of that person as a councillor

PART 4. – GENERAL,

4.1 If any provision of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a Court, all other provisions remain valid.

PART 5 – REPEAL,

5.1 Bylaw No. 1995-02 is repealed in its entirety


PART 6 – ENACTMENT,

6.1 This Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon the duly elected Council members being sworn into office at the organizational meeting following the 2021 Local Authorities Election.


