TOWN OF TROCHU BYLAW NO. 2022-03 RATES & FEES BYLAW

BEING A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF TROCHU IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH A RATES, FEES & PENALTIES BYLAW.

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, *Statutes of Alberta*, 2000, *Chapter M-26.1* as amended or replaced from time to time, Council may pass a bylaw respecting rates fees & penalties;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Trochu deems it necessary to set the rates, fees & penalties as set out in Schedule A (Garbage); Schedule B (Water and Sewer); Schedule C (Animal Control Penalties); Schedule D (Administration); Schedule E (Public Works); Schedule F (Arena); Schedule G (Swimming Pool); Schedule H (Cemetery); Schedule I (Campground Fees); and Schedule J (Fire Related Offence Fees);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROCHU DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Schedules A; B; C; D; E; F; G; H; I; and J hereto attached and forming part of this bylaw establishes the rates, fees & penalties for this Bylaw.
- 2. That Bylaw NO. 2021-01 is hereby rescinded.

This Bylaw shall take effect January 1, 2022.

GST EXEMPT.

UTILITY SERVICE BASIC RATES

- a) All utility accounts shall pay a basic water service fee of \$30.00/billing period (\$15.00/month)
- b) All utility accounts shall pay a basic sewer service fee of \$10.00/billing period (\$5.00/month).
- c) If a residential customer has a property that will not be occupied for more than three months, they may request that their account be put "on Holiday" by giving Town Office one month notice. There will be no utilities charged except for these basic service charges in this case.

WATER AND WATER RATES

- a) Residential and Commercial customers will be charged \$3.62/m³ of water used.
- b) Unmetered accounts will be charged a flat fee of \$60.00.
- c) Trochu Golf and Country Club will be charged \$2.43/m³ of water used.
- d) Those meters currently reading imperial measurements will be converted to metric measurements for billing purposes.

SEWER

- a) Residential and Commercial customers will be charged a fee of \$.80/m³ of water used with the exception of Trochu Golf and Country Club.
- b) Unmetered accounts will be charged a flat fee of \$60.00.
- c) Those meters currently reading imperial measurements will be converted to metric measurements for billing purposes

REFUNDABLE WATER DEPOSITS

a) Deposits collected prior to Bylaw 2015-02 will be refunded on rental accounts when account is closed providing the account is current. No interest is payable on deposits.

UTILITY ACCOUNT PENALTIES

- a) Any utility charges that remain unpaid for more than thirty (30) days will incur a penalty of 1.5 % per month, totaling 18% per annum.
- b) Any utility account that remains unpaid for 3 billing periods or holds a balance over \$1000.00 is subject to shut-off of services and a transfer of the balance to the property tax roll with a \$50.00 administrative fee. A final notice will be mailed to the utility account holder and owner of the property, if different from the utility account holder, informing of shut off and associated fees.

RECONNECTION FEE

In the event of a shut off due to non-payment the	re will be a \$200.00 recon	nection fee payable
prior to water being reconnected.
