### Program Overview from AB Gov't website

Immigrate and start a business in Alberta

Alberta is a great place to start your own business. Albertans have an entrepreneurial spirit supported by a young, educated, and diverse workforce. Starting a business is easy in Alberta as we have the lowest corporate tax in Canada and no provincial sales tax.

We welcome talented newcomers and job-creating entrepreneurs who will move to, live and work in Alberta.

In collaboration with the (CARES) Community and Regional Economic Support and (CAEP) Central Alberta Economic Partnership, the Town was granted funding to compile a 2022 Community Profile.

Council believes this to be a great

tool for anyone interested in starting or expanding a business.

Copies will be available by email or hard copies can be picked up at the office.

As we endeavor to keep utility and tax account information up to date, please notify the office if your information has changed.

Examples; married last name, new mailing address, phone number, email, etc.

In addition, if you are paying online, please note there are separate payees for your Utility Account & Taxes.

To ensure payments are recorded accurately use your Utility Account Number (found in the middle at the bottom of your utility billing) & Tax Roll number (found in the top left corner of the Taxation Notice) as the account number, no extra numbers are needed.

If you are on our tax installment payment program (TIPP's) and require updated payment amounts or are changing the payment dates, please contact the Town Office.

## The Importance of Having House & Business Numbers

### ***House/business numbers are mandatory as per Section 3 of Bylaw 1985-5***

Please consider the following points for;

- **Emergency responders** - to locate those in need. When responding to an emergency, minutes matter so be sure that fire, ambulance, and police personnel can easily and quickly find your address.
- **Utility operators** - gas, power, water, internet, etc.
- **Contractors, suppliers, couriers**
- **Convenience for family & friends**

***It is recommended that all Town residents and business owners take a few moments to install house/business numbers or examine existing house/business numbers. Be sure that the numbers are easily read from the street and close to a light if possible (for reading at night).***

Please consider the following;

- Script numbers or numbers that are spelled out in words may be aesthetically pleasing but are difficult to read quickly from the street.
- Brass and Bronze numbers are difficult to see. Use numbers that contrast with the background.
- Be sure that the view of the numbers is not obstructed by shrubs, trees or decorations, such as flags.
- Numbers should be clearly seen when approaching from **either side** of the house. ***Utility workers or emergency responders may need to access your property from the back alley, so it is important to consider placing numbers on your fence, back of house or garage, or even a post near the back property line of your lot.***
