Utility Account - Information Update

2024 Rates & Fees Changes

To keep up with the rising cost of water from our supplier, there will be some increases in utility service fees and water usage rates.

Starting with the January/February bills, residential fees will be as follows:

Service	Previous Fee	New Fee
Basic Water Services	\$30.00	\$32.00
Basic Sewer Services	\$10.00	\$10.00
Water Usage (1m ³ =220 gal.)	\$3.88/m ³	\$4.07/m ³
Sewer Usage (1m ³ =220 gal.)	\$0.86/m ³	\$0.86/m ³
Recycling Pickup	\$9.50	\$10.00
Garbage Pickup	\$40.00	\$41.00
Fees are billed out every 2 months		

Billing Example: A two-person household using an average 25m³ of water (5,500 gallons) per billing cycle paid \$208.00 previously. **They will now pay \$216.25, an increase of \$8.25 per billing cycle or \$4.13 per month.**

Other changes include small increases to some Arena fees (not in effect until the start of the next ice season, late 2024) and Pool fees. To see the full bylaw, please stop by the office or find it on our website under Inside Town Hall > Bylaws & Policies.

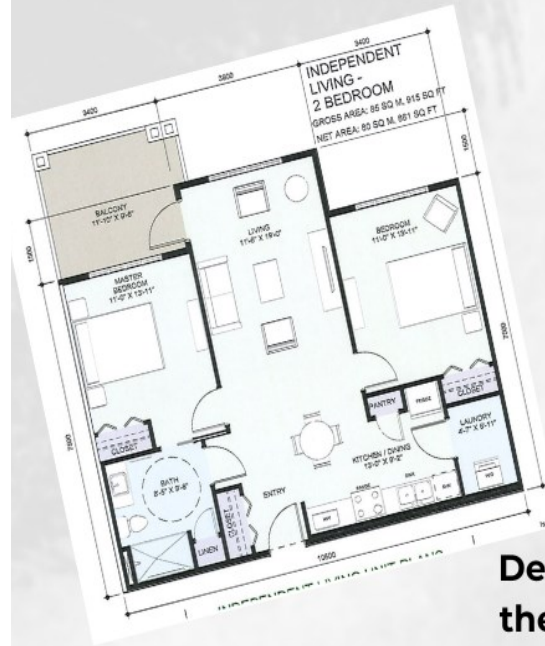
• Senior and Junior Lifeguard
