When delivering waste to the Trochu Transfer Site, please have your materials sorted.

There are several different areas available for a variety of collection

- electronics,
- small appliances/electrical items,
- paint cans,
- propane bottles,
- aerosol cans,
- batteries,
- large appliances,
- freon appliances,
- tires,
- cardboard,
- newsprint,
- wood and other burnable pits,
- metal pile

This is in conjunction with the bins for normal household garbage.

Furniture bins are brought in every May for the full month.

All transfer sites are required to follow guide-

lines set forth by the Alberta Government. Some items are not accepted at this Transfer Site and will need to be taken to Drumheller Landfill or possibly another Landfill that will accept them.

All recycle containers should be clearly marked and put at the curb to ensure they are not missed. Cardboard should be flattened and large bundles tied to prevent them blowing around on windy days. ## Garbage Collection ...

Community garden plot and raised garden bed occupants, please pull and pile your waste, **by Oct 18th**, at the north east corner of both areas (near the alley and near the road) and we would be happy to dispose of it for you... Failure to clean your plots may result in refusal of use next growing season.

Final compost collection will be Friday November 1st - time permitting.

Weekly garbage collection is Wednesdays and limits are three bags per household.

Extra weekly bag tags can be purchased at the Town Office for \$1 each.

### Trochu Town Council has passed a new Land Use Bylaw

Check it out on our website or stop by the  
Town Office to view

Some changes between the new Bylaw and  
the previous one include:

- No Development Permits required for some signs, fences, minor home occupations, and solar panels;
- Increased ability of the Development Officer to relax regulations to a certain point;
- Slight dwelling density increases in residential districts, such as allowing Duplexes in the R-1 District;
- Creation of a new District type (R-1S Small Lot Residential) for potential future use;
- Greater detail and more allowance for the construction of Accessory Dwelling Units (basement suites, garage suites, garden suites, etc.);
- Removal of telecommunication structures regulations (a new Telecommunication Structure Policy has been created separately)
