

Building Permits

Do You Need a Permit & What Kind?

If you are planning construction or renovations on your property, you will most likely need a development permit from the Town and possibly building, plumbing or electrical permits from Palliser Services. Certain projects like repair work or walkways do not require permits but please call the Town Office to make sure.

Not having a permit may result in a Stop Work Order from the Town.

Examples of projects that do require development & often more permits are:

- new fences
- sheds, tarp sheds & garages
- decks
- pools & hot tubs
- home businesses
- structural home renos

Fire Bans

The Town of Trochu follows Kneehill County Fire Ban Restrictions.

- you can also refer to the Town of Trochu Fire Services Bylaw, on the Town website for all general inquiries regarding acceptable practices within the Town limits.

Safety First

With Summer on the way, it's soon time for us to enjoy our backyard fire pits. Here are a few guidelines to follow. Should you have any questions you can contact any member of the Trochu Fire Department.

Your backyard fire pit must:

- be at least 3 meters (10 feet) from buildings, property lines and anything else that could catch fire
- be less than 0.6 meters (2 feet) high
- be less than 1 meter (3 feet) wide
- have enclosed sides made from bricks, concrete or heavy-gauge metal

Burning the Proper Fuels - the only things that can be burned in an outdoor fire pit are: clean (non-treated), dry wood, charcoal and preservative-free wood or wood products. Burning yard waste, garbage, paper or anything that might create too much smoke or toxic smoke is prohibited. Never burn old pallets, lumber or plywood.

Community Updates

The Town of Trochu (The Town) and Dillon Consulting Limited (Dillon) are in the process of amending the Northwest Area Structure Plan (NWASP). The NWASP was first released in 2020 to provide a roadmap for the future development of an area of land in the northwest part of the Town, which is shown in the map below. Five years have passed since the NWASP was adopted, which means a review of the NWASP is required. This review will enable the Town to incorporate changes to align with the 2024 updates to the Town of Trochu's Municipal Development Plan (MDP) and to consider amendments required to enable the plan to reflect what is needed in the Town, such as different housing forms.





The NWASP amendment will include several minor revisions to the plan, including land use, roads, and service alignments. Some of these changes include the following:

- Map updates to reflect infrastructure changes
- Updated language to align with the Town's new Bylaws and Policies
- Updated tables based on 2021 Census data

- · Refreshing sections to align with the revised development concept
- Reduced Municipal Reserve to accommodate more housing
- Changes to the layout of the residential
- Adjustments to incorporate revisions to the ATCO right-of-way

The NWASP amendments are being prepared and will be shared on the website when ready for public review. The NWASP Amendments are anticipated to be considered by Council in June 2025, and the public can attend this Public Hearing to share their thoughts about the amendments before the revisions are adopted.
