## e) ACE Trails

They have some grant applications in such as a federal legacy grant related to the Centennial in the amount of \$149,000.00 and have received contributions of \$10,000.00 each from a ACE Grant and from the Elks. There are several contributions of in kind services. They have \$5000.00 from Communities in Bloom and \$1000.00 from the proceeds of fundraising. They would like to apply for the maximum funding amount of \$75,000.00 from a Community Initiative Grant Program. This is a matching grant. Chris Vokins entered the meeting and outlined funding.
