Local businesses enthusiastic about the taste of Trochu event, very good ideas coming forth from community.

The Community Hall is getting some new stuff and asked the Town if we are interested in some round tables they no longer need.

Mayor Barry Kletke

Wild Rose Alliance thanked AUMA in a letter for letting them speak at convention.

Mayor Kletke read questions from a municipal survey AUMA would like comments on from councils. Council will discuss survey at council retreat this week and decide if they wish to share their ideas.

Attended Mayor's symposium in Edmonton. Keynotes from symposium were sustainability, stay away from long term plans as short term plans may take 7 years to implement, allow staff input, Mayor should participate in debate and run meetings efficiently. Other keynotes were:

Mayors need to lead not manage, have fun, Media policy, build relationships with media Chamber of commerce talked about how they lobby for fireman's coverage, another border crossing, and business owners that do not live in town should still have a vote.

Alberta Infrastructure toured the Trochu School and they feel optimistic about the future of the school. Trochu has fewer students leaving grade 12 then students starting Kindergarten which is positive.
